WITT PROPERTY (11.1574 ACRES), ALL LOCATED TO THE SOUTH OF THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF GREENBELT IN THE VICINITY OF THE GREENWAY SHOPPING CENTER AND HANOVER PARKWAY, TOGETHER WITH ADJACENT PUBLIC ROADWAYS, AND FURTHER PROVIDING FOR THE SPECIAL TREATMENT OF THE UNDEVELOPED TAXABLE REAL PROPERTY IN THE AREA ANNEXED FROM THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF ANNEXATION FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS OR, IF SOONER, UNTIL THE ISSUANCE OF BUILDING PERMITS.

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF GREENSBORO ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY OF ARTICLE XI-E OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND AND ARTICLE 23A OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND; TO REPEAL AND RE-ENACT THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF GREENSBORO AS SET FORTH IN ARTICLE 6 OF THE CODE OF PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF MARYLAND (1965 EDITION AS AMENDED).
