AN ACT concerning

Contract Procedure - Purchasing

FOR the purpose of amending the Baltimore County Charter by ~~increasing--the--limit--on--small--purchases--which--do--not--require--certification--by--the--Director--of--Finance--and--providing--that--such--limit--may--be--increased--by--legislative--act--of--the--County~~ providing that the dollar limit on small purchases which do not require certification by the Director of Finance may be changed by legislative act of the County Council; by providing that manufacturers equipment maintenance agreements and contracts for services which have been competitively bid do not require council approval; to eliminate the written announcement prior to competitive and noncompetitive negotiations; and to raise the dollar amount of contracts requiring competitive bidding and providing that such amount may be ~~increased~~ changed by legislative act of the County Council.
