

hear complaints and render advice, prohibiting officials and employees from having certain outside employment under certain circumstances; imposing certain employment restrictions on current and former officials and employees; forbidding, with exception, the use of county office for private gain; prohibiting the solicitation and acceptance of certain gifts; prohibiting the disclosure of confidential information; requiring certain persons to file certain financial disclosure statements with the commission; providing for enforcement and criminal penalties for certain violations and generally relating to the regulation, control and subject matter of conflicts of interest, financial disclosure, lobbying disclosure and ethical conduct of county officials in accordance with the requirements of Article 40A, Title 6 of the Annotated Code of Maryland.
