near central business districts and transit station development areas wherein the minimum lot area requirement of 1.5 acres for housing for the elderly or handicapped may be reduced.

AN AMENDMENT to Section 59-C-9, title "Rural Zone," Subsection 59-C-9.3, title "Exempted Lots and Parcels," Subsection (d), to provide that the overall density of a grandfathered lot shall not exceed one dwelling unit per five acres in any subdivision recorded as of October 1, 1981.

AN AMENDMENT to Division 59-A-2, title "Definitions and Interpretations," Section 59-A-2.1, title "Definitions," Division 59-G-2, title "Special Exceptions - Standards and Requirements," Section 59-G-2.58, title "Temporary Structures, including wayside stands for the sale of farm products," to provide for the establishment and use of temporary real estate and construction offices without requirement for special exception.

AN AMENDMENT to Section 59-C-4.0, title "Land Uses," to allow automobile parts supplies and tire stores as a permitted use, with restrictions, in the C-1 Zone.

AN AMENDMENT to Division 59-C-7, title "Planned Unit Development Zones," Section 59-C-7.13, title "Uses Permitted," to allow the development of housing for the elderly or handicapped at a height in excess of four stories in Planned Development (PD) Zones.
