

administrative leave for appearances before judicial and administrative bodies on government business other than that of the County; (10) requiring that the County pay the employer's share of benefit costs for employees in a leave without pay status due to job-related disability; (11) providing additional bases upon which an employee may be placed in a leave without pay status; (12) providing that an employee who receives a workmen's compensation temporary award shall be entitled to reimbursement of the employer's share of benefit costs incurred while on approved leave without pay; (13) providing that part-time employees shall be entitled to four (4) hours of personal leave annually; (14) requiring that personal leave not be segmented; and (15) making certain technical amendments.

AN ACT concerning

Amendment of Section 817B, Charter of
