 - (9) The following types of retail establishments:
- (i) Drugstores whose principal business is the
 sale of drugs and related items[.];
- (ii) Delicatessens whose principal business is
 the sale of delicatessen and related items[.];
 - (iii) Food stores[.];
 - (iv) Bakeries and bakeshops[.];
- (v) Gasoline stations whose principal business
 is the sale of gasoline, oil, and other automobile maintenance
 items[.];
 - (vi) Restaurants, grills, and snack bars[.];
 - (vii) Antique dealers and flea markets[.];
 - (viii) Dealers in boats and boating equipment,
 and dealers in fishing equipment and supplies[.];
 - (ix) Realtors or businesses which sell or rent real property[.];
 - (x) Hotels, motels, rooming houses or other provisions of lodgings[.];
 - (xi) Journalism, newspapers, radio and television broadcasting; and
 - (10) The sale and delivery by a retailer of any of the following items:
