32.11.03.02 Grants for Treatment Services

To become available immediately upon passage of this budget to supplement and adjust the appropriations for fiscal year 1983 to provide Federal Funds in lieu of General Funds due to the increased availability of Federal Funds under the Alcohol, Drug Abuse and Mental Health Block Grant.

General Fund Appropriation..... -360,000

Federal Fund Appropriation, ~~provided that federal funds received in excess of the federal funds appropriation from the Alcohol, Drug Abuse and Mental Health Block Grant shall not be expended but shall be placed in the federal fund reserve for the block grant until the reserve fund for the block grant is increased by an amount equivalent to the fiscal year 1983 deficiency appropriation.
