CHAPTER 64

(Senate Bill 538)

AN ACT concerning

Reorganization of State Government baber, Employment and Training

FOR the purpose of establishing a Department of Labor, Employment and Training within the Executive Branch; transferring certain employment security, training, and placement functions performed by the Department of Human Resources and its constituent agencies, including the Employment Security Administration-7- and the Training and Employment Office and ether---units---implementing---the---Federal---Comprehensive Employment-and-Training-Act-to-the-Department; transferring certain employment training functions performed by the Department of Licensing and Regulation, including the Apprenticeship and Training Council, to the Department; abolishing the Employment Security Administration; deleting certain obsolete language and correcting certain terminology relative to those units; generally relating to the creation of the Department of Labor, Employment and Training and the reorganization of State government to implement the creation of the principal department; making provisions of this Act severable; and providing for the termination of <u>certain</u> provisions of this Act subject to the provisions of the Program Evaluation Act.
