Section 5-202(e) and (f)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1978 Volume and 1982 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

5-202.

(e) The following are additions to State shares:

(1) [(i)] For fiscal year [1983] 1984 only, these amounts are targeted to 12 low per pupil expenditure, low wealth, and at least average revenue effort counties:
