

(2) -- Election -- by --- Nonprofit --- Organization --- and Governmental --- Entities. --- Any --- nonprofit --- organization --- which, pursuant to § 20(g)(7) of this article is or becomes -- subject -- to this article on or after January 1, 1972, shall pay contributions under -- the -- provisions -- of -- subsections -- (a) -- (b) -- and -- (e) -- hereof, unless it elects in accordance with this paragraph, to pay to the Executive Director for the unemployment insurance fund an amount equal -- to -- the -- amount -- of -- regular -- benefits, -- ADDITIONAL BENEFITS and one-half -- of -- the -- extended -- benefits -- paid, -- that -- is -- attributable -- to service -- in -- the -- employ -- of -- such -- nonprofit -- organization -- to individuals -- for -- weeks -- of -- unemployment -- which -- begin -- during -- the effective period -- of -- that -- election. -- Any -- governmental entity -- which elects in accordance with § 8(f) to be liable for payment in lieu of -- contributions -- shall -- pay -- to -- the -- Executive Director for the unemployment insurance fund an amount equal -- to -- the -- amount -- of -- all regular -- benefits, -- ADDITIONAL BENEFITS and the appropriate share of -- any -- extended -- benefits -- paid, -- that -- is -- attributable -- to -- base period -- wages -- in -- the -- employ -- of -- such -- governmental entity -- to individuals -- for -- weeks -- of -- unemployment -- which -- begin -- during -- the effective period -- of -- that -- election. -- With respect to governmental entities, -- the appropriate share of -- any -- extended -- benefits -- shall -- be one-half -- of -- all -- extended -- benefits -- paid -- for -- weeks -- of -- unemployment beginning -- on -- or -- before -- December 31, 1978, -- and all -- extended benefits -- paid -- for -- weeks -- of -- unemployment beginning after -- December 31, 1978. -- However, -- a -- nonprofit -- organization or governmental entity -- shall -- not -- be -- required -- to -- pay -- to -- the -- Executive Director -- the amount -- of -- any -- benefits -- paid -- to -- an -- individual -- whose -- base -- period wages -- include -- wages -- for -- previously -- uncovered -- services, -- as -- defined in -- § 20(n-1) -- of -- this -- article, -- to -- the -- extent -- that -- the -- fund -- is reimbursed -- for -- the -- benefits -- under -- the -- Unemployment -- Compensation Amendments of 1976.

(i) -- Any -- nonprofit -- organization -- which -- is, -- or becomes, -- subject -- to -- this -- act -- on -- January 1, 1972, -- may -- elect -- to become -- liable -- for -- payments -- in -- lieu -- of -- contributions -- for -- a -- period of -- net -- less -- than -- one -- taxable -- year -- beginning -- January 1, 1972, provided it files with the Executive Director a written notice of its election -- within -- the -- 30 -- day -- period -- immediately -- following -- the date -- or -- within -- a -- like -- period -- immediately -- following -- the -- date -- of -- enactment -- of -- this -- subparagraph, -- whichever -- occurs -- later.

(ii) -- Any -- nonprofit -- organization -- which -- becomes subject -- to -- this -- act -- after -- January 1, 1972, -- may -- elect -- to -- become liable -- for -- payments -- in -- lieu -- of -- contributions -- for -- a -- period -- of -- net less -- than -- 12 -- months -- beginning -- with -- the -- date -- on -- which -- that subjectivity -- begins -- by -- filing a written notice of its election with the Executive Director not later than 30 days immediately following the date of the determination of that subjectivity.

(iii) -- Any -- nonprofit -- organization -- which -- makes -- an election in accordance with subparagraph (i) or subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph will continue to be liable for payments in lieu of -- contributions -- until -- it -- files -- with -- the -- Executive Director a written notice terminating its election not later than 30 days prior -- to -- the -- beginning -- of -- the -- taxable -- year -- for -- which -- that
