~~{A} WHEN USING RADIATION FOR THE PURPOSES OF DENTAL DIAGNOSIS OR THERAPY, A LICENSED DENTIST SHALL COVER A PATIENT'S BODY FROM THE SHOULDERS TO THE LEGS WITH A PROTECTIVE MATERIAL HAVING A LEAD EQUIVALENCY OF 0.5 MILLIMETERS SHALL BE PROTECTED UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A LICENSED DENTIST. CHAPTER 75

(Senate Bill 19)

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - Belair Mansion

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of ~~\$1,500,000~~ \$500,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the City of Bowie for the purpose of renovation, restoration, rehabilitation, repair, alteration, and improvement of the Belair Mansion; requiring that the City of Bowie provide a certain matching fund of a certain kind for the same purpose by a certain date; providing that certain easements be granted to the Maryland Historical Trust; and providing generally for the issue and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Belair Mansion Loan of 1983 in the aggregate principal amount of ~~\$1,500,000~~ \$500,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance and sale of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold and delivered in accordance with
