SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article 75A - Public Accountancy

11A.

- (a) Any [Maryland resident] PERSON who is the holder of an original or reciprocal certificate of "certified public accountant," but who is not required to obtain a biennial enrollment certificate, shall register specially with the Board on a biennial basis. [Such] THE registration shall be accompanied by a fee, not to exceed \$10, and shall expire biennially on the last day of December of each even-numbered year.
- (b) Any holder of an original or reciprocal certificate who fails to register as required by this section may not be permitted to register for any subsequent year until the current registration fee, plus an amount equal to the total of the registration fees for the intervening years but not to exceed \$15.00, is paid to the Board. The Board may revoke or suspend the original or reciprocal certificate of any holder who fails to register with the Board for a period of three successive years.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1983.

(Senate Bill 80)

Certain Licensing Boards - Continuation
