

FOR the purpose of establishing certain license renewal fees for occupational therapy assistants and physical therapist assistants.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Health Occupations
Section 9-311(c)(2) and 13-311(c)(2)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1981 Volume and 1982 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health Occupations

9-311.

(c) Except as otherwise provided in this title, before the license expires, the licensee periodically may renew it for an additional term, if the licensee:

(2) Pays to the Board a renewal fee equivalent to an annual fee of \$25[;], EXCEPT THAT AN OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY ASSISTANT SHALL PAY A RENEWAL FEE EQUIVALENT TO AN ANNUAL FEE OF \$10; and

(c) Before the license expires, the licensee periodically may renew it for an additional 1-year term, if the licensee:

(2) Pays to the Board a renewal fee of \$25[;], EXCEPT THAT A PHYSICAL THERAPIST ASSISTANT SHALL PAY A RENEWAL FEE OF \$10; and

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1983.
