- FOR the purpose of authorizing requiring the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene to conduct-those-inspections-required-or necessary-to-enforce-the-provisions-of-the-Maryland-Water Quality-Laboratory-Certification-Act;-and-eliminating-a requirement-that-the-Secretary-have-each-water-quality laboratory at least triennially.
- BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Health - Environmental Section 9-1003 Annotated Code of Maryland (1982 Volume)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health - Environmental

9-1003.

- $-\{-(a)-\}-$ The Department shall:
- (1) Adopt rules and regulations to carry out the provisions of this subtitle;
- (2) Establish a proficiency testing program to test the performance of any water quality laboratory; -{-and-}-
 - (3) Set standards for:
- (i) Demonstrating satisfactory performance in a proficiency testing program; and
 - (ii) Conducting the program-{-.-}-,-AND
- -{-(b) The Secretary shall have each water quality laboratory inspected annually AT LEAST TRIENNIALLY.-}-
- (4)--GONDUCT--THOSE--INSPECTIONS-REQUIRED-OR-NECESSARY TO-ENFORCE-THE-PROVISIONS-OF-THIS-SUBTITEE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1983.
