DETERMINE COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE RELATING TO CONTROLLED HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES.

- (F) AN ADMINISTRATIVE SEARCH WARRANT ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE EXECUTED AND RETURNED TO THE JUDGE BY WHOM IT WAS ISSUED WITHIN:
- (1) THE TIME SPECIFIED IN THE WARRANT, NOT TO EXCEED 30 DAYS; OR
- (2) IF NO TIME PERIOD IS SPECIFIED IN THE WARRANT, 15 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF ITS ISSUANCE.
- (G) ANY INFORMATION OBTAINED PURSUANT TO AN ADMINISTRATIVE SEARCH WARRANT SHALL BE CONSIDERED AS CONFIDENTIAL AND MAY NOT BE DISCLOSED BY--THE--DEPARTMENT'S--OFFICIALS,--EMPLOYEES,--OF CONTRACTUAL-PERSONNEL EXCEPT TO THE EXTENT UTILIZED IN AN ADMINISTRATIVE OR JUDICIAL PROCEEDING.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this  $% \left( 1\right) =1$  Act shall take effect June 1, 1983.

## CHAPTER 116

(Senate Bill 270)

AN ACT concerning

Mass Transit - Prohibited Acts
