AN ACT concerning

Unemployment Benefit Claims - Rights of Interested Persons Employer's Right to Appear

FOR the purpose of providing that, in certain proceedings involving the evaluation of a claim for unemployment benefits, an interested person may appear and present evidence; and providing for the representation of an interested person in certain circumstances employer may appear for itself or by certain others.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
