CHAPTER 130

(Senate Bill 443)

AN ACT concerning

Medical Assistance Program - Reimbursement

FOR the purpose of altering the method of establishing Medical Assistance reimbursement rates for medical day care services by providing that a maximum per diem rate shall be established by regulation of the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Health - General Section 15-111 Annotated Code of Maryland (1982 Volume and 1982 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health - General

15-111.

- (a) The Department may authorize reimbursement of a licensed day care center for the elderly or medically handicapped adults for medical care that the center provides to a Program recipient who is certified as requiring nursing home care.
- (b) (1) Reimbursement under this section is subject to the availability of federal funds.
 - (2) The reimbursement rate for medical day care:
- (i) [May not be more than 75 percent of the maximum per diem rate under the Program for comprehensive long term care facilities; and] MAY NOT EXCEED A MAXIMUM PER DIEM RATE ESTABLISHED BY REGULATION OF THE DEPARTMENT; AND
- (ii) Shall be on a cost related basis and shall include costs as required for the following:
 - 1. Administrative overhead.
