

(2) -- IS LISTED IN THE LATEST CURRENT FILE OF THE NATIONAL INSTITUTE FOR OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH REGISTRY OF TOXIC EFFECTS OF CHEMICAL SUBSTANCES,

(3) -- HAS YIELDED POSITIVE EVIDENCE, KNOWN TO THE EMPLOYER, OF AN ACUTE OR CHRONIC HEALTH HAZARD IN HUMANS OR ANIMALS, OR

(4) -- HAS A MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET OR OTHER INFORMATION AVAILABLE TO THE EMPLOYER INDICATING THAT THE MATERIAL MAY BE A HEALTH HAZARD.

(J) -- "WORK AREA" MEANS ANY ROOM OR DEFINED SPACE, WHETHER WITHIN OR OUTSIDE OF A BUILDING OR OTHER STRUCTURE, WHERE TOXIC OR HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES ARE PRESENT, PRODUCED, USED, OR WHERE EXPOSURE COULD OCCUR.

(K) -- "WORKPLACE" MEANS ANY LOCATION WHERE ANY EMPLOYEE PERFORMS ANY WORK RELATED ACTIVITY IN THE COURSE OF EMPLOYMENT REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE LOCATION IS TEMPORARY OR PERMANENT.

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(A) -- THIS SUBTITLE APPLIES TO:

(1) -- ANY EMPLOYER WHO USES OR STORES ANY HAZARDOUS OR TOXIC SUBSTANCE IN THIS STATE,

(2) -- ANY PERSON WHO IMPORTS OR SELLS ANY HAZARDOUS OR TOXIC SUBSTANCE TO ANY EMPLOYER IN THIS STATE, AND

(3) -- ANY MANUFACTURER WHO PRODUCES, REPACKAGES, DISTRIBUTES, OR SELLS ANY HAZARDOUS OR TOXIC SUBSTANCE IN THIS STATE.

(B) -- THIS SUBTITLE DOES NOT APPLY TO ANY HAZARDOUS OR TOXIC SUBSTANCE THAT IS A FOOD, DRUG, COSMETIC, OR TOBACCO PRODUCT IF THE SUBSTANCE IS INTENDED FOR PERSONAL CONSUMPTION BY EMPLOYEES WHILE IN THE WORKPLACE OR FOR DISTRIBUTION TO AND USE BY THE GENERAL PUBLIC AS A CONSUMER PRODUCT.

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(A) -- EACH EMPLOYER SHALL DEVELOP AND MAINTAIN A CHEMICAL INFORMATION LIST WHICH SHALL CONTAIN THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION FOR EACH HAZARDOUS OR TOXIC SUBSTANCE PRESENT IN A WORKPLACE:

(1) -- THE COMMON NAME,

(2) -- THE TRADE NAME, AND

(3) -- A CROSS-REFERENCE TO THE SUBSTANCE'S CHEMICAL NAME.
