

(3) -- THE GOVERNOR, WITH THE ADVICE OF THE SENATE, SHALL DESIGNATE THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMISSION. THE CHAIRMAN SERVES AT THE PLEASURE OF THE GOVERNOR.

(C) -- UPON TAKING OFFICE, EACH COMMISSIONER SHALL TAKE THE OATH REQUIRED BY ARTICLE 17, SECTION 9 OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION.

(D) - (1) -- THE TERM OF A COMMISSIONER IS 5 YEARS.

(2) -- THE TERMS OF COMMISSIONERS ARE STAGGERED AS PROVIDED FOR THE INITIAL APPOINTMENTS TO THE COMMISSION.

(3) -- AT THE END OF A TERM, A COMMISSIONER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED.

(4) -- A COMMISSIONER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REMAINDER OF THAT TERM.

(5) -- THE GOVERNOR MAY REMOVE A COMMISSIONER FOR INCOMPETENCE OR MISCONDUCT AFTER NOTICE AND A HEARING.

(E) - (1) -- THE INITIAL APPOINTMENTS SHALL BE MADE AS FOLLOWS:

(2) -- 1 COMMISSIONER EACH SHALL BE APPOINTED FOR TERMS OF 1, 2, 3, 4, AND 5 YEARS.

#### 5A:

(A) - (1) -- THE COMMISSION SHALL APPOINT A HARNESS RACING ADMINISTRATOR AND A THOROUGHBRED RACING ADMINISTRATOR.

(2) -- EACH ADMINISTRATOR SERVES AT THE PLEASURE OF THE COMMISSION.

(B) -- EACH ADMINISTRATOR SHALL:

(1) -- POSSESS THE QUALIFICATIONS SPECIFIED FOR THE ADMINISTRATOR IN THIS ARTICLE, AND

(2) -- EXERCISE ALL OF THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE OFFICE OF THE ADMINISTRATOR PROVIDED IN THIS ARTICLE SUBJECT TO THE JURISDICTION OF THE COMMISSION.

#### 5B:

(A) -- EACH ADMINISTRATOR SHALL BE QUALIFIED BY TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE TO PERFORM THE POWERS AND DUTIES SPECIFIED IN THIS ARTICLE.

(B) -- EACH ADMINISTRATOR SHALL DEVOTE FULL TIME AND ATTENTION TO THE OFFICE AND MAY NOT ENGAGE IN ANY OTHER PROFESSION OR OCCUPATION.

(C) -- EACH ADMINISTRATOR IS AN UNCLASSIFIED STATE EMPLOYEE.
