- (d) Before the license expires, the licensee periodically may renew it for an additional 2-year term, if the licensee:
 - (1) Otherwise is entitled to be licensed;
- (2) Pays to the Board the appropriate renewal fee specified by this [subsection:] SUBTITLE; AND
 - [(i) A certified social worker......\$50;
 - (ii) A graduate social worker......\$50; and
 - (iii) A social work associate.....\$20.}
 - (3) Submits to the Board:
- (i) A renewal application on the form that the Board requires; and
- (ii) Satisfactory evidence of compliance with any continuing education requirement set under this section for license renewal.

Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Program Evaluation Act, this title and all rules and regulations adopted under this title shall terminate and be of no effect after July 1, [1984] 1994.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That an applicant employed as of July 1, 1983 by an agency of the State or of any political subdivision of the State, and for that reason previously exempt from social work licensure requirements, shall be issued a license without examination if the Board is satisfied that the applicant has fulfilled the appropriate educational and experience requirements. Such a waiver may not be granted after June 30, 1984. Until July 1, 1984, an employee of the State or a political subdivision of the State may not be prosecuted for practicing social work without a license.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1983.
