CHAPTER 209

(House Bill 404)

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore County - Board of Education Student Nonvoting Member

FOR the purpose of repealing the expiration date of provisions of law relating to a student nonvoting member of the Baltimore County Board of Education; and providing that the law creating a student nonvoting member of the Baltimore County Board of Education continue in effect.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

3-109.

- (a) The Baltimore County Board consists of 10 members who shall be appointed as follows:
 - (1) One from the county at large;
- (2) One from each of the eight legislative districts that are wholly or partly in Baltimore County; and
 - (3) One student member from the county at large.
