- (ii) A nursing facility or visiting nurse service that is conducted only by or for adherents of a recognized BONA FIDE church or religious denomination ORGANIZATION, in accordance with tenets and practices that include reliance on treatment by spiritual means alone for healing; or
- (iii) Any sheltered housing for the elderly, as defined in Article 70B, § 1 of the Code, that is certified by the Office on Aging, unless the housing provides for more than 11 individuals:
- 1. In one building that does not have more than one apartment unit; or
- 2. If there are apartment units in the building, in one apartment unit.

- (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (2) (i) "Abuse" means [cruel or inhumane treatment that causes:

i. Any physical injury; or

- 2. Any neglect that is detrimental to physical or mental well-being; and] THE NONTHERAPEUTIC INFLICTION OF PHYSICAL PAIN OR INJURY, OR ANY PERSISTENT COURSE OF CONDUCT INTENDED TO PRODUCE OR RESULTING IN MENTAL OR EMOTIONAL DISTRESS.
- (ii) "Abuse" does not include the performance of an accepted medical procedure that a physician orders.
- (3) "Law enforcement agency" means the Maryland State Police or a police agency of a county or municipal corporation.
- [(4) "Nursing home" means a related institution that is classified as a nursing home.]
- (b) (1) A person who believes that a resident of a [nursing home] RELATED INSTITUTION has been abused [promptly] shall report PROMPTLY the alleged abuse to an appropriate law enforcement agency [and to], the Secretary, OR THE OFFICE ON AGING.

(2) A report:

- (i) May be oral or written; and
- $\mbox{\ \ (ii)\ \ Shall\ \ contain\ \ as\ much\ information\ as\ the\ reporter\ is\ able\ to\ provide.}$
