- (D) (2) (I) ANY VACANCY ON THE COUNTY BOARD THAT OCCURS ON OR BEFORE THE FILING DEADLINE FOR CANDIDATES IN AN ELECTION HELD IN THE FOURTH YEAR OF THE TERM OF OFFICE OF ANY MEMBER SHALL BE FILLED, FOR THE REMAINDER OF THAT TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS ELECTED AND QUALIFIES, AT THE GENERAL ELECTION:
 - 1. NEXT FOLLOWING THE CREATION OF THE

VACANCY; AND

- (II) ANY OTHER VACANCY, INCLUDING A VACANCY EXISTING DURING THE PERIOD PRECEDING THE ELECTION OF A SUCCESSOR AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (1), SHALL BE FILLED BY A QUALIFIED INDIVIDUAL APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS SELECTED AND QUALIFIES.
- (1) SHALL BE GOVERNED BY SUBTITLE 32 OF ARTICLE 33 OF THE CODE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1983.
