- (a) The Board may deny, suspend, or revoke a certificate or license if a licensee or an applicant has violated or is violating the provisions of this subtitle. In addition, the Board may deny, suspend, or revoke a certificate or license if the Board finds that an applicant or licensee:
 - (1) Has falsified records submitted to the Board; or
- (2) Engages in habitual pattern of drunkenness or drug use; or
 - (3) Demonstrates gross incompetence; or
- (4) Fails to utilize proper sanitary methods in the practice of barbering; OR
- (5) FAILS TO MAINTAIN A BARBERSHOP IN A SANITARY CONDITION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1983.

CHAPTER 250

(House Bill 858)

AN ACT concerning

State Soil Conservation Committee - Membership

FOR the purpose of permitting a member of the State Soil Conservation Committee to designate a certain alternate member to serve on the Committee; and clarifying language.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Agriculture Section 8-201(a) Annotated Code of Maryland (1974 Volume and 1982 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
