CHAPTER 254

(House Bill 875)

AN ACT concerning

Washington County - Alcoholic Beverages - License Board

FOR the purpose of altering the salary of a member of the License Board of Washington County;-providing-that-this-Act-does-not apply-to-incumbents;-and-generally-relating-to-the-salary-of a-member-of-the-bicense-Board-of-Washington-County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages Section 155(u) Annotated Code of Maryland (1981 Replacement Volume and 1982 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

155.

(u) In Washington County each member of the board shall be entitled to receive an annual salary of [\$1,800] \$3,7600 \$2,800 payable monthly from the license fees derived from the issuance of license fees authorized by this article. No member or employee of the board shall have any pecuniary or other interest in any phase of the manufacture, sale or distribution of any alcoholic beverages.

SECTION-2---AND-BE-IT-FURTHER-ENACTED, That-this-Act-may-not be--construed--to--extend--or--apply-to-the-salary-of-the-License Board--Commissioner--of--Washington--County--in--office--on---the effective--date--of--this-Act--but--the--provisions-of-this-Act concerning-the--salary--of--the--License--Board--Commissioner--of Washington--County-shall-take-effect-at-the-beginning-of-the-next following-term-of-office-

SECTION 3 $\underline{2}$. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1983.
