

(D) (1) THE GOVERNOR MAY PROVIDE, USING STATE FUNDS ALONE IF NECESSARY WHERE FEDERAL EXPENDITURES ARE LIMITED BY THE FEDERAL ACT, TRAINING ALLOWANCES, EXPENSES, STIPENDS AND SUPPORTIVE SERVICES THAT ENABLE ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUALS TO PARTICIPATE IN STATE TRAINING SERVICES.

(2) PERMISSIBLE SUPPORTIVE SERVICES UNDER THIS SUBSECTION INCLUDE THE PROVISION OF FINANCIAL COUNSELING, HEALTH CARE, OR CHILD CARE TO ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUALS WHO PARTICIPATE IN STATE TRAINING SERVICES.

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(A) SUCH SUMS OF STATE FUNDS AS REQUIRED IN SECTION 304 OF THE FEDERAL ACT TO OBTAIN THE FULL AMOUNT OF FEDERAL FUNDS AVAILABLE TO THE STATE FOR EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING ASSISTANCE TO DISLOCATED WORKERS UNDER TITLE III OF THE FEDERAL ACT SHALL BE APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR DURING WHICH THE FEDERAL ACT REMAINS IN EFFECT.

(B) ADDITIONAL STATE FUNDS MAY BE APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET TO PROVIDE TRAINING FOR THE ECONOMICALLY DISADVANTAGED FOR EACH YEAR DURING WHICH THE FEDERAL ACT REMAINS IN EFFECT.

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(A) EXCEPT FOR FUNDS RESERVED FOR ADMINISTRATION AND FOR STATE ADMINISTERED STATEWIDE PROGRAMS UNDER TITLE III, THE GOVERNOR SHALL DISTRIBUTE, BY MEANS OF SUBGRANT AWARDS TO LOCAL SERVICE DELIVERY AREAS, THE REMAINDER OF FEDERAL FUNDS ALLOCATED TO THE STATE UNDER TITLE III OF THE FEDERAL ACT AND SUCH STATE FUNDS AS ARE APPROPRIATED FOR TITLE III PROGRAMS.

(1) THE AMOUNT OF FEDERAL FUNDS ALLOCATED UNDER TITLE III OF THE FEDERAL ACT WHICH TOGETHER WITH RELATED STATE MATCHING FUNDS ARE SUBGRANTED TO ANY LOCAL SERVICE DELIVERY AREA SHALL NOT EXCEED 200 PERCENT OF THAT LOCAL SERVICE DELIVERY AREA'S PERCENTAGE SHARE OF THE TOTAL NUMBER OF UNEMPLOYED INDIVIDUALS WITHIN THE STATE AS OF THE MOST RECENT MONTH FOR WHICH THE REQUISITE UNEMPLOYMENT DATA IS AVAILABLE.

(2) THE AMOUNT OF STATE FUNDS FOR TRAINING ECONOMICALLY DISADVANTAGED INDIVIDUALS WHICH ARE SUBGRANTED TO ANY LOCAL SERVICE DELIVERY AREA SHALL NOT EXCEED 200 PERCENT OF THAT LOCAL SERVICE DELIVERY AREA'S PERCENTAGE SHARE OF THE TOTAL NUMBER OF ECONOMICALLY DISADVANTAGED INDIVIDUALS WITHIN THE STATE AS MEASURED IN DETERMINING THE ALLOCATIONS OF TITLE II OF THE FEDERAL ACT.

(B) SERVICE DELIVERY AREAS SHALL EXPRESS INTEREST RECEIVING SUBGRANT AWARDS BY SUBMITTING PROPOSALS TO THE GOVERNOR. SAID PROPOSALS SHALL HAVE THE CONCURRENCE OF THE PRIVATE INDUSTRY COUNCIL AND THE APPROPRIATE CHIEF ELECTED OFFICIAL (S) WITHIN THE SERVICE DELIVERY AREA. SEPARATE PROPOSALS SHALL BE SUBMITTED FOR
