2. Is designed or set with the intent of capturing an animal by the neck.

- (ii) "Snare trap" includes:
 - 1. A pole snare;
 - 2. Hanging snare; and
 - 3. Neck snare.
- (2) In Baltimore, Carroll, CECIL, and Harford counties, a person may not use, sell, possess, set, place, or maintain a snare trap.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1983.
