Dear Mr. Speaker:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 590.

This bill authorizes the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$500,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the City of Bowie for the purpose and renovation, restoration, rehabilitation, repair, alteration and improvement of the Belair Mansion.

Senate Bill 19, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 10, 1983, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 590.
