

H.B. 623-Anne Arundel County - Repeal the provision that will terminate, after a certain date, the authority granted to Anne Arundel County to levy a sales or use tax on certain goods and services25 (28)

H.B. 650-Maryland Industrial and Commercial Redevelopment Fund - Provide that certain loans may be undertaken or entered into by certain counties or Baltimore City without regard to certain limitations and without complying with certain procedures26 (29)

H.B. 708-Collection agencies - Provide that the surety bond required to be paid to the Commissioner of Consumer Credit by a collection agency is for the use and benefit of debtors and creditors in addition to certain members of the public28 (30)

H.B. 920-Emergencies - Allow the State Board of Medical Examiners and the Commission on Medical Discipline to adopt rules and regulations to permit emergency medical technician-paramedics to perform certain acts without a license to practice medicine under certain conditions and relating thereto29 (31)

H.B. 977-Maryland Self-Service Storage Act - Regulate the use of leased space at a self-storage facility and generally relating thereto30 (32)

H.B. 1007-Tax Increment Financing Act - Provide for the disposition of any amounts retained during any fiscal year in any special fund for a development district and generally relating thereto31 (33)

H.B. 1030-Corporations and associations - Require special voting on certain transactions involving interested stockholders and make corresponding changes to the provisions governing the rights of objecting stockholders33 (34)

H.B. 1041-Real Estate Conservation Areas - Provide that the Real Estate Commission shall provide certain information to a community when the Commission is considering a removal or modification of a Real Estate Conservation Area36 (35)

H.B. 1083-Energy and weatherization assistance programs - Require the Governor to apply certain federal funds to the weatherization assistance program, the energy assistance program and the energy extension service and require that the funds be used for certain purposes ..37 (36)

H.B. 1278-Election Code - Revise provisions for the selection of delegates to national political party conventions for the nomination of presidential candidates and generally relating thereto39 (37)

H.B. 1331-Controlled dangerous substances - Provide that the court may impose a fine on a person given probation before judgment for violations40 (38)

H.B. 1386-Parole - Provide the period of time a person who has been sentenced to life imprisonment as a result of a proceeding under Article 27, Section 413 must serve in jail before becoming eligible for parole41 (39)
