AN ACT concerning

Division of Labor and Industry - Commissioner and Deputy Commissioner

FOR the purpose of permitting the Commissioner of Labor and Industry to appoint the Deputy Commissioner with the approval of the Secretary of Licensing and Regulation; clarifying that the office of Commissioner is a full-time office; allowing the deputy holding office on the effective date of this Act to continue in the position subject to Article 64A; repealing certain provisions relating to the selection and salary of the deputy; repealing certain obsolete provisions; and generally relating to the Commissioner and Deputy Commissioner of the Division of Labor and Industry.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 89 - Division of Labor and Industry Section 1 Annotated Code of Maryland (1979 Replacement Volume and 1982 Supplement)
