

And att last this Dfond^t for Supply and releif of the Compt^t necessity agreed
 with him in Manner and forme following that is to say that he the said Compt^t
 Should enter and Seate upon the sait one thousand acres of Land of the other
 Dfond^t And that in case the other Dfond^t upon his Returne from England Should
 refus to convey & assure to the Compt^t such Estate of Inheritances of the Promis^r
 as was vsuall in this Province in case of like nature in Consideration of Twenty
 Thousand pounds of Tobacco that is to say two Thousand pounds of Tobacco for
 every one hundred Acres of Land or so much of her the said Compt^t Land att the —
 Ridge which he pretended he was then Seized of in fee in like thereof or part —
 Tobacco & part land att the choice of the other Dfond^t Nathaniell and in case
 the said Dfond^t Nathaniell Should refus to make good the said Sale or —
 Exchang this Dfond^t did minge to remburs the Compt^t such charges as he
 Should bee att in Seating clearing and building appon the Promis^r and
 Belied he gav the Compt^t an oaks under his hand to that purpose And
 therupon the Compt^t entered and became posses^d of the Promis^r but was
 not putt into possession by this Dfond^t And he further said that about —
 the moneth of Januari in the yeare of our Lord one Thousand Six hundred
 Sixty Scavon the other Dfond^t Nathaniell returning from England =
 the Df^t acquainted him with the agreement abovesaid whereupon —
 the said other Dfond^t declared and made knowne to the Compt^t his willing =
 nofe and readinesse to Confirm the same and to accept of Twenty Thousand
 pounds of Tobacco for his mitorst in the Promis^r and to make such Con =
 voyance of the Inheritance thereof as was vsuall in like case in case the ~
 Compt^t would have paid or reasonable Secured the payment of the said =
 twenty Thousand pounds of Tobacco which he altogether refus and negatived
 to doe neither did he pay or Secured the payment of the same or any part =
 therof to the Dfond^t knowledge but continued the possession of the promis^r
 and afterwards the other Dfond^t agreed with the Compt^t that in case the ~
 Compt^t would pay the said Df^t one Thousand pounds of Tobacco and assure
 the Inheritance of five hundred Acres of good Land upon the Ridge —
 part of the mannor there belonging to the Right hon^rble the Lord Proprietary
 Such as this Dfond^t should approve of unto the said other Dfond^t or —
 Such as he should appoint the said other Dfond^t would convey and assure
 the said one Thousand acres of Land unto the Compt^t in fee simple And
