 therewithall served he appeared by his attorney aforesaid but shewed noe  
 cause to the contrary of the Reviving of the suite aforesaid whereupon  
 the said former suite and all the Proceedings thereupon were by an order of  
 this Court revived to stand in the same plight and condition as the  
 same were at the tyme of the Death of the said Thomas Mathew the  
 elder And the said Cause is standing this present day was appointed for  
 hearing thereof on wednesday upon hearing & debating of the matter in  
 question as aforesaid and upon Reading of the said Bill and answer &  
 the severall depositions taken in this cause and that by the same proofs itt  
 did well and sufficiently appear and the whole Court were fully satisfied  
 and so declared that the said William Hawley did make a will in writing  
 and thereby did devise and bequeath all the said severall lands tenements  
 and premises aforesaid to the Compt<sup>er</sup> his godsonne & his heires for  
 ever and that the said will was in the tyme of the late Usurpation by Henr<sup>ie</sup>  
 and faller or (as his hon<sup>or</sup> the Chanc<sup>er</sup> thought) it might be recorded by  
 Henry the 8<sup>th</sup> in the yere one thousand six hundred and sixty being during that  
 said Usurpation of them and their Compt<sup>er</sup> and that itt might be burnt  
 with other their pretended Records by his Hon<sup>or</sup> the Chanc<sup>er</sup>, according to  
 an order given him by the Right hon<sup>or</sup> the Lord C<sup>h</sup> and that the said  
 Nicholas Guyther father of the Complainant had noe Right or title in Law  
 or Equity to sell or dispose of any part of the said Land & premises to  
 any person or persons whatsoever from the said Compt<sup>er</sup> in whom only  
 the Estate was and that the said Compt<sup>er</sup> being an Infant under age was  
 not bound by any act done by his Father or any other as his Guardian  
 so much to his Prejudice and that all Contracts and Sales by the said  
 Nicholas Guyther or any other since the Death of the said William  
 Hawley and during the minority of the said Compt<sup>er</sup> are voyd in Law and  
 that the said Defend<sup>ts</sup> title in and to the said four hundred Acres of Land  
 ought to be sett aside and that the Defend<sup>ts</sup> Thomas Mathew the elder  
 had sufficiently reimbursed himselfe the purchase money by him supposed  
 to be paid by the perception of the meane profits with an overplus and that  
 the title of all other the said Defend<sup>ts</sup> in the Bill mentioned to any part  
 the said Land and premises by vertue of any Sale or purchase from the  
 said Nicholas Guyther are likewise voyd and of noe force to bar the  
 Claim
