

His Lordship the Lord Prop. of this Province sendeth his writ of
 Scire facias to the Sheriff of St. Marys County which followeth in
 these words vizt Wher eas we have made inspection into the
 Records of our said Province of Maryland in our Survey Office
 remaining wheresoev'r appeareth amongst other things that
 certifying our late Father of noble memory the eighteenth day
 of July one thousand five hundred forty two under the great
 Seal of our said Province did Grant unto Thomas Gerard
 gentl a tract of land bounding upon the South with
 Potowmack River, upon the West with Micoomico
 River, upon the East with St. Clements Bay, upon the
 North with a right line drawn from a Crook in Micoomico
 River called Gerards Crook South Easterly to the nearest
 Branch of a Creek in St. Clements Bay called the Fresh Creek.
 And likewise three Islands the one in Potowmack River
 called S. Clements, the second in the mouth of S. Clements
 Bay called S. Matthews Island, & the third lying near unto it
 in the mouth of Micoomico River called S. Margarets
 Island, the said tract of land & Islands containing six thousand
 acres in the whole or thereabouts Upon such consideration
 Under such reasonable provisoes as in the same is expressed
 reserved And for that upon Information that the said
 Grant to the said Thomas Gerard granted in the time thereof
 doth not comprehend above four hundred acres of land, but
 that the pieces of the said land are nearly mistaken, & yet
 under colour the said Thomas Gerard in his life time & those
 that claimed under him since his death have held as their
 own land a very great quantity of land by which we & our
 said Father have bin defrauded of our rents for the passage
 lands more than the six thousand acres mentioned in the
 said Patent And we being willing that the truth of the
 premises should be fully discovered have caused the said tract
 of land to be Resurveyed laid out anew by John Manley
 gentl Deputy Surveyor under our trusty & wellbeloved Baker
 Brooks Esq; our Surveyor Generall of our said Province reported
 to be passed by the said Grant to the said Gerard deceased,
 whiche said Deputy Surveyor hath made returne of the Report
 under his hand into our said Office that the said tract of land
 containeth eleven thousand four hundred acres By which
 it is evident & apparent that our said Father of noble memory
 hath bin defrauded in the said Grant, & that Patent for the
 same was unduly illegally & surreptitiously obtained to the
 dismission of us & our heires and the said Thos: Gerard
 being deceased & the possession of the premises being in
 Justian Gerard gentl sonne & heire of the said Thomas dead
