

Where the before comend you that by good & lawfull men of your
 bailiwit you make known & give warning to the said Justiciar
 Gerard that he be & appears before us in our Court of Chancery the
 Eighteenth day of this instant June where so ever it shall be holden
 to show cause if any he hath why the said Letters Patent for the
 said land so surreptitiously obtained ought not to be revoked &
 advanced & made void upon Record, & the same into our hands be
 seized, & to do & receive what our said Court shall consider of in
 this behalf. And in what manner you execute this precept you
 make known unto us the day aforesaid & have you shew this
 writ with our seals at the City of St. Maryes the seventh day
 of June in the third year of our Dominion of Anno Domini
 1678.

At which said Eighteenth day of June in the year
 aforesaid the same Sheriffe maketh returne of the precept
 aforesaid endorsed, that by virtue thereof he had made
 known unto Justiciar Gerard before Henry Bonner and
 John Heard good & lawfull men of his bailiwit that he
 should make his personall appearance here at the day and
 place aforesaid, as by the said precept he was comanded. Whereupon
 the said Justiciar Gerard being solemnly called appeared by
 Nicholas Blakiston his Attorney And whereupon Kenneth
 Chiseldyn Esq. his Lordps Attorney Gen^l on the behalfs of his
 Lordps offered himself against the said Justiciar Gerard and
 desired that the Patent aforesaid for the reasons aforesaid should
 be advanced vacated & made void And the said Justiciar Gerard
 by his Attorney aforesaid nothing in barre thereof alledgeth,
 but the said Patent so surreptitiously obtained as aforesaid to this
 Court delivered & surrendered. Whereupon after due & mature
 consideration had & taken of & upon the premisses And the said
 Patent & Certificate of Resurvey being duly pondered & considered
 this Court doe order adjudge & decree the said Patent & all and
 singular the outgoes thereof to be null & void to all intents &
 purposes whatsoever And that the same Patent be immediately
 cancelled in open Court by the Hon^{ble} Philip Calvert Esq.
 Chancelour of this Province, & that the outgoes thereof be
 vacated upon Record And the same land into his Lordps
 hands to be seized. Which said Patent was in open Court by the
 said Chancelour cancelled & made void according to the order and
 decree aforesaid.
