 Assembly here to be held and consent to such things as by Common Consent shall
 happen to be Ordained, and Enacted in the business aforesaid so that through want
 of sufficient Power or Jurisdiction the Election of the aforesaid Delegates the
 business aforesaid may not be demanded or neglected, and make your Return
 of this writ into the Secretaries Office by the second day of October next, sign
 with the names of the said Delegates and the said City as
 aforesaid Given at our said City of Saint Marys this 15th day of September in the fourth year of our
 Dominion over our said Province Anno Domini 1671
