personal Estate all Just debts and disbursements the p^{ts} over paid for taxes
that the p^{ts} the tenth day of June 1677 performed the said Award & executed
to have Enjoyed the said plantation awarded and received the money by
shewed to the said Compt^{ts} the tenth day of January following, and have
had his amount allowed according to award, that Dorsy and his wife entered
upon the plantation shewed to the p^{ts} and their possessors, the sum of
the personal Estate of the said Thomas to the value of one hundred
pounds standing with two servants, that the bonds of Arbitration were
left in the hands of the Arbitrators in trust for the p^{ts} with the p^{ts} to
to deliver, that upon the plantation called the Quantin delivered to Dorsy

Thomas did submit all differences to the Award of the Chancellor who
not only as Arbitrator but as Judge Testamentary declared the Liew
bound, and the upon the said Dorsy had Liew of Adam granted and
granted an Inventory amounting to Eighty thousand pounds of Tobacco
that the D^{ts} Edward was Attorney to the Compt^{ts} & managed the Estate
of Wyatt, that the Chancellor settled all Accounts, that the D^{ts}
Edward was shewed to pay into the Compt^{ts} Thomas sum of one thousand
pounds
