

Graves allowance herof, and also of severall other  
 disbursements expenses and payments made the said J. Ferd  
 Edwards, and also of severall damages sustained by occasion of  
 the said Edwards his unjust and illegal entering upon  
 the plantation properly belonging to the said Thomas by the  
 said Edwards, and also making use of and converting to his  
 own use severall crops of tobacco goods Mart and other  
 servants and other things properly belonging to the said  
 Thomas and also denying to pay him severall sums of tob  
 and deliver him possession of what was shewed to the said  
 Thomas as well by the Shewers of the house the Chancery as  
 by the Shewers of the Defendants Burges and Taylor, the  
 Court had thought fitt that Richard Hill out of the Dist  
 to the Dist be dismissed with costs, and also that Colton  
 William Burges out of the Dist be dismissed, and that  
 the Comp<sup>ts</sup> Thomas be possessors of all and singular the premises that  
 and shewers to the Comp<sup>ts</sup> Thomas in the Shewers of the  
 J. Ferd Burges and Taylor, and that the Dist Doufy deliver  
 the same to the Comp<sup>ts</sup> Thomas, and that the amount of the  
 Comp<sup>ts</sup> Thomas and all other matters between the said Thomas  
 and Doufy depending in this Court or at Common Law be stopp  
 by injunction of this Court so and are hereby referred by this  
 Court to the honorable Cotton Henry Darnall and Cotton Henry  
 Jacobs to examine and certify that the same, and to make  
 their Report to this Court of their proceedings therein  
 at St Marys the tenth day of February next, and that they  
 the said J. Ferd Cotton Darnall and Jacobs meet at such  
 time and place to doe the same as to them shall seeme most  
 they giving convenient notice to both parties when and where to  
 attend them, and that Cotton Darnall make Report to this  
 Court if the Dist Burges ought to have costs against the Comp<sup>ts</sup>  
 upon his dismissal he being the Trustee of that deed that is by  
 the Court varied, and has sold the Estate pursuant to the  
 Deed to the Dist Doufy, and that the said J. Ferd have  
 the Copies of all proceedings and dispositions in this Case  
 and that Commission issued out of this Court to empower them
