

Then M^r Carvill's objection aforesaid, & insisting upon his want of timely notice, the Compt^r, though he had proved his serving the Auditors warrant as aforesaid, did proffer that he should defend the paying the charges of this day's meeting, It should be adjourned to a further day, but then M^r Carvill the Defendant's Attorney refused, then did the Auditors call for the Defendant Dowsy in and told him what they had proffered to his Attorney who replied that what his Council did he consented to, but no further would think upon it. Then the Auditors proceeded to examine the Compt^r into the Compt^r Examination, then upon the Auditors calling again for M^r Dowsy to know whether he would acknowledge a Receipt that M^r Bland all ad goods was his, for certain bills, Dowsy looking upon the name to the Receipt, acknowledged it was his hand, but upon reading the Receipt it self he denied that ever he had signed that writing, and by that time his Attorney M^r Carvill was followed him into the presence of the Auditors and they forbade him to confess or deny any thing, or to answer at all before them, then told the Auditors that he could not give their Commission, and they advised his Agent as he did, least his Agent should do himself any wrong.

Then the Auditors proceeded to Examination of the Compt^r accounts, and upon what appeared before them to have been proved, allowed to the said Compt^r as followeth
