being appointed for hearing this Court, and the Defend
being served with a subpoena to hear Judgement, doir
appear and the Compt^{ts} Attorney likewise, the cause the
coming to hearing this day before his Excellency Charles Calvert Esq^r Governour
of this Province and Chief Judge in Equity, the hon^{ble} Philip Calvert Esq^r
Chancero of this Province, and the Rest of their Honors Justices of this Court
and upon hearing and Debating thereupon, and upon reading the Compt^{ts} bill
and the Defend^s answer therunto, with the Depositions and proofs taken in
this cause being all by this Court seriously viewed and considered, and hearing
of what could be alleged on either side, this Court was all fully satisfied
that the Depositions taken in this cause for the Complainant be entered upon
Record, and so preserved for the future, that they may be good Evidence for the
Compt^{ts} touching the Land in the bill and answer mentioned, in case the witness
should by before the same come in Dispute, and that the bill be dismissed out
of this Court as to any Judgement to be had thereupon, and that the Compt^{ts} Halfhead
pay the Defend^s Costs, since the institution of the filing of that bill was only to
show his Evidence, and there being no Reason the Defend^s should be at the
Charge to preserve the same. It is therefore ordered and Decreed by this Court
that the Depositions taken in this cause for the Compt^{ts} be entered upon
Record, in the Records of this Court, and that the bill be dismissed out of
this Court as to any Judgement of this Court to be had touching the same, And
this Court doir further order adjudge ordaine and Decree that the Compt^{ts}
John Halfhead pay to the Defend^s Joseph Edor the sume of two thousand
pounds of Tobacco for his Costs accordingly.
