

Prayed that the signing and Enrolling of the said Decree might be  
 stayed untill such time as the said Court should take a copy of the said  
 Report, and if they had occasion might put in Exceptions therunto  
 all-adding the said Report had not duly passed the said Ord. of  
 Reference, but it appearing to this Court that the said Report had  
 duly followed the direction of the said Ord. and that the said Court  
 and d:ts had been duly heard before the said Report by themselves &  
 their Attorneys, and they had bound themselves up by their Oath  
 in Court to stand to such the said Report Ord. Award & finall  
 Judgment aforesaid. This Court thought not fit to alter the said Report in  
 any thing, but doth Ord. and Decree that the said Report Ord. Award  
 Dooms Judgment and finall Determination of the said Court Thomas  
 Tayl. Henry Darnall and Thomas Truman. Be: and is hereby  
 Ratified and Confirmed to be observed performed fulfilled & kept by  
 both the said p:ts to all intents and purposes according to the true  
 intent and meaning hereof according to the said former Ord. without  
 any other or further Motion or appeal from the same or reversal  
 thereof. And whereas the said d:ts did here p:fer in Court and unto  
 the Coupls to deliver unto him the bill of Sale of the p:sonall  
 Estate in the said Report long hee was thereby ordered to deliver to the  
 Coupls as also have all beed bonds Receipts and papers belonging  
 to the said Coupls and by him the d:ts taken in for him the Coupls  
 And was ready to sign the said bill of Sale as by the said Report  
 hee was ordered to give make and Execute If the Coupls would execute  
 his Comerce to draw it, but the Coupls refused to receive the said bill  
 of Sale of the p:sonall Estate aforesaid, or the beed bonds Receipts or  
 papers aforesaid, or to procure a Release to be Drawn for the d:ts  
 to Execute It is therefore ordered that the said d:ts do have in the  
 Custody of the Register of this Court the bill of Sale and writings  
 aforesaid thereto by for the Coupls to receive the same of free place  
 and that the Coupls do pay unto the said d:ts the Costs of this  
 suits to be taxed by the Secretary or Register of this Court
