 twenty five thousand eight hundred and eighty pounds of Tobacco, and did
 procure the Comptroller for Trinity for that sum to Mortgage to him
 the said D^{ts} all his the said Comptroller's Land and Real Estate of
 the Value of One hundred thousand pounds of Tobacco, and that
 then he would Red-empt to the Comptroller all the goods belonging to
 his personal Estate, and then upon the Comptroller did about the 10th
 and Twentieth day of May in the year 1677 signe his the said
 for the Consideration of the said sum of twenty five thousand
 eight hundred and eighty pounds of Tobacco but Comptroller or Mortgage
 to the said D^{ts} and his heirs for ever for seven hundred acres
 of Land with the house buildings and appurtenances lying in
 Salway County of the Value of One hundred thousand pounds
 of Tobacco, also by the said D^{ts} (of which he looketh no Copy or
 Countroll or Declaration from the said D^{ts} in Writing to deliver up
 the Mortgage of the personal Estate) may also if produced appear
 in the said account, was also included the remainder of the Tobacco unpaid
 upon the Mortgage of the personal Estate and more by sum of the said
 Justly due, yet the said D^{ts} kept the Comptroller's bills and Engagements for
 sum of the said D^{ts} had paid and taken Trinity for and also kept
 possession of all the goods Cattle plate and other things to the Value
 of four hundred pounds of Tobacco as aforesaid, and kept
 on foot the said Mortgage of the personal Estate, and the said D^{ts}
 having so far proceeded did upon the thirty the day of January
 in the year of our Lord 1677 put into the Comptroller one other Comptroller
 or Mortgage for six hundred Acres of Land parts of the
 seven hundred Acres of Land aforesaid, the Contents of which
 was that the Comptroller should for and in Consideration of Eighteen
 thousand pounds of Tobacco Comptroller the said six hundred Acres
 of Land to the said D^{ts} and his heirs for ever, with this proviso
 that the said Comptroller should Red-empt the said by paying the said
 D^{ts} or his Assignes twenty eight thousand pounds of Tobacco
 upon the fourth day of February 1679 as by the said D^{ts} if
 produced might also appear, the said D^{ts} then affirming that
 all his former Accounts aforesaid relating to the personal and Real
 Estate do be just and due due to him the said D^{ts}, and that he
 would Comptroller the Comptroller to pay the same, & therein to
