& every of their appurtenances containing five hundred Acres to him  
the said deft Mortgagee by the said D<sup>o</sup> of the first of Aprill one  
thousand five hundred twenty eight as aforesaid to the only and proper  
use and behoof of the said George Parker his heirs and assigns for  
ever against the said Joseph Selley Com<sup>rs</sup> his heirs and assigns  
lawfully acquitted and discharged of all and all manner of incumbrances  
whatsoever. and also freed cleared discharged and barred of all  
Equity of Redemption by the said Joseph Selley his heirs or assigns  
for ever being a full Discharge of Eighteen thousand pounds of  
Tobacco part of the Twenty nine thousand four hundred eighty and one  
pounds of Tobacco aforesaid, And they did also thereby ord award  
adjudge and finally Determine that the said Com<sup>rs</sup> Joseph Selley  
should pay unto the said deft his Ex<sup>ors</sup> Adm or assigns the sum  
of Eleven thousand four hundred eighty and one pounds of Tobacco  
Residue of the said sum of Twenty nine thousand four hundred  
eighty and one pounds of Tobacco Principall as aforesaid as full  
paid and paid as hereafter is mentioned, and they did also allow  
unto the said D<sup>o</sup> for his damages for forbearance of his Tobacco  
aforesaid (See Necessary allowance for reception of Office & other  
allowances whatsoever deducted) the sum of Eight thousand five  
hundred and nineteen pounds of Tobacco. w<sup>ch</sup> they did thereby ord  
the said Com<sup>rs</sup> to pay unto the said deft his Ex<sup>ors</sup> Adm or assigns  
in manner and form following hereafter mentioned, w<sup>ch</sup> said sum of  
Eight thousand five hundred and nineteen pounds of Tobacco, and the  
said sum of Eleven thousand four hundred eighty and one pounds  
of Tobacco amounting in the whole to the sum of Twenty thousand  
pounds of Tobacco. They did thereby ord Adjudge and Award should  
be paid and satisfied by the said Com<sup>rs</sup> his heirs Ex<sup>ors</sup> Adm  
or assigns in manner following. That is to say that the said Joseph  
Selley his heirs Ex<sup>ors</sup> Adm or assigns. Do well and truly
