

The said Comp hath bin not only served with a sup for the payment of the
 said Costo but also with a writ of Execution of the said Decree & the Costo
 hath bin demanded of him but hee hath refused to pay the same as by
 the Affidavits of Jamo Crawford may appere. Whereupon process of
 Contempt issued out against the said Comp. for Nonpayment of the said
 Costo and he hath bin taken upon the same and lye now in Prison in
 the Custody of the Sheriffe of N. Mary. County for nonpayment of
 the said Costo. And a writ of Execution of the said Decree hath been
 directed to the said Comp. under the Seal of the Court. Whereby he is
 enjoined to performe what on two parts ought to be performed. The one
 George Curwen did upon the thirtenth day of Aprile last past by virtue
 of a Letter of Attorney under the hand and Seal of the said George Parker
 bearing date the eighth day of Aprile last past. Affirming and Demanding of
 the said Comp. if he would performe and yield obedience to the said Decree
 and would pay unto him the said George Curwen for the use of the said George
 Parker the said sum of Ten thousand pounds of Tobacco
 by the said Comp. to the said Decree as also the said Twelve thousand six
 hundred fifty two pounds of Tobacco Costo aforesaid. And the said George
 Curwen did at the same time and into the said Comp. a writing with a Seal
 to the same effect purporting to be a Letter of Attorney whereby hee the
 said Comp. was to authorize and empower the said George Curwen in the
 name and stead and as his Attorney to Enter into and upon all the
 premises with the appurtenances mentioned and proposed in the Decree of Mortgage
 or lease before recited Or into or upon some part thereof as is not by the said
 Decree Ordre and Adjudged Or into any part thereof in the Name of the
 whole And peaceable and quiet possession and Seizin therof for him and in
 his name to take. And after such possession and Seizin therof had & taken
 as aforesaid for him the said Comp. in his Name stead and place
 peaceable and quiet possession Leasur and Seizin of all and singular the said
 premises or any parts thereof in the name of the whole to deliver unto the
 said George Parker the heire or Assignee or to his or their Certain
 Attorney in that behalf And to ratify and Confirm all and what
 for the said Attorney should be done or to be done in or about
 the premises. And the said George Curwen did then and there Deliver
 the said Comp. to have and receive the said Letter of Attorney to him
 the said George Curwen in manner aforesaid but the said Comp. did
 absolutely refuse to pay the said Twelve thousand six hundred fifty two
 pounds of Tobacco Costo or the said Twelve thousand pounds of Tobacco
