

Command was given to the Sheriff of Calvert County That Whereas by a certain order made in the High Court of Chancery the 18th day of May 1682 Downy 1682 In a cause there then depending between Joseph Tully Camp. and George Barker defendants It was for the reasons therein contained ordered That a Commission should issue to the said Sheriff to be Directed forthwith to put and keep the said George Barker the defendant in the quiet and peaceable possession of the Plantation house Lands and appurtenances to the same belonging of him the said Joseph Tully at Hunting Creek in Calvert County aforesaid and Mortgage of Lands to the said defendant, And that the said George Barker the heirs Executors and Assigns may quietly and peaceably hold and enjoy the said Mortgage or Lands premises or so much thereof as not before ordered awarded against the said Joseph Tully and his heirs and assigns Heirs and also discharged and barred of all equity of redemption according to the decree made in this cause. It was therefore commanded the said Sheriff that immediately after the receipt thereof having taken with him sufficient Savor of the said County of Calvert aforesaid. And in the proper person should go to the plantation house and Lands late of the said Joseph Tully in Hunting Creek aforesaid. And if there he found any person or persons whatsoever in possession of the said plantation house and Lands aforesaid that then and every of them you cause to quit and leave the possession thereof. And that you put in the said George Barker and his assigns into the quiet and peaceable possession of the said plantation house and Lands late of the said Joseph Tully at Hunting Creek aforesaid and him the said George Barker in full quiet and peaceable possession thereof from time to time you keep and maintain against the said Joseph Tully or his heirs or assigns. Whereof at the next day of June 1682. Whereupon Cecelia Henry Dowler Sheriff of Calvert County aforesaid made return of the writ aforesaid in manner following Viz

June 16 1682

By virtue of the writ to me Directed I have Delivered the writ in name of George Barker quiet and peaceable possession of the within mentioned plantation house and Lands formerly appertaining to Joseph Tully of Hunting Creek
