

pth nor according to the said Memorandum or the Dedy of Land
 purchase or for the worded over good about to defeat the pth of any
 Land or estate given by the said Memorandum or two Dedy nor
 ever claimed any right or title to that pth of Land purchase rowing
 to the pth nor to the Land called for the worded nor to half of Bluepland
 till the pth sold the same to Gily Richard as afore said and they deny
 that the said Gily Richard ever threatened or desired the pth to
 deliver up any writings from Deand to Brown and believe there
 was never any such for they cannot find any such nor any
 Gily Richard papers and they deny any fraud or any attempt
 or combination with John Ocan used by Gily Richard to
 defeat the pth of any their Land or that the said Gily Richard
 ever enticed the said John Ocan from the pth house but have
 heard his remove was occasioned through the disobedience
 morose behaviour of the pth Edward and they further say they
 have heard and hope to prove that upon the treaty of
 marriage between Gily Richard and Susanna Ocan the said
 John Ocan did give the said Gily Richard that as he had
 given the pth half of Land purchase and half of Bluepland
 all for the worded and half of his personall estate (which was then
 considerable) for he would give the other half of Land purchase
 and Bluepland to his daughter Susanna and according by the
 28th of April 1684 John Ocan by Dedy of Gift indentured writing
 his interest in Land purchase and Bluepland and setting out
 the bound of both the said Land and writing also the Dedy
 made to the pth by the Dedy of the 28th of April 1693 of his
 motion and free will did give and grant to the said Susanna
 the other moiety of Land purchase (50 Acres excepted by
 not adjoining to the pth moiety) and the moiety of Bluepland to
 the said Susanna and her heirs for ever which Dedy is known
 to be the alienation paid and recorded and by vertue
 whereof she became seised of that moiety and the said Gily
 Richard after their marriage in her right claimed the same
 and about September 1686 the said Susanna dyed leaving
 the said Susanna the Dedy her heir That the said Gily after
 marriage the said Dedy Mary at which time she was seised
 Land purchase and about September 1687 the said Richard
 made his will and gave his moiety of Land purchase to his
 wife for life remainder to his daughter Susanna and her
 heirs and Dedy. And by that right the Dedy claimed to keep
 the Land and for justify the keeping possession thereof. And
 to divers other matters and things in the Bill not here to be
 answered unto referred or answered. Similarly the gift of a moiety
 in freem marriage by the Memorandum and the other moiety
 the Dedy and all the rest of the Bill they are advised the pth
 contains many irregularities falsehoods and impositions
 as do afford to the Dedy sufficient cause to plead in bar to the
 former and therefore they demure in Law and for cause of
 demure show that the pth claims right to all Land purchase
 and by their own showing make title out to half of it. Also
