The Declaration of Mr Henry Spinks of *S<sup>t</sup> Marys County* taken before us John Watson and Philip Lynet of *S<sup>t</sup> Marys County* Gent. especially appointed by virtue of a Commission to us directed out of the High Court of Chancery to examine and inquire upon oath concerning a certain parcel of Land lying in *Sabrot County* called the Rip that is now in dispute between John Dought of *Sabrot County* plaintiff and Samuel Watkins of the same County Defendant which said Commission is to the w<sup>ch</sup> contents annexed. By virtue of which Commission we caused the sd Henry Spinks Sen<sup>r</sup> to come before us this ninth day of November One thousand six hundred Ninety Three who did at the sd time upon his oath declare unto us as being by us examined upon several Interrogatories as touching the sd Land & what he knew any ways relating to the same Land as written follows.

*1<sup>st</sup>*

Interrogatory the Depondent upon his oath saith that Nicholas Harvay was the Depondent Master and that he served the greatest part of his time upon Mr Harvays Land lying in *Protupent* it being the same Land that first Mr George Beckwith and Mr Thomas Banks both lived upon & that amongst several neighbours there was much grumbling supposing that there was much more quantity of Land than Mr Harvays Survey made mention of. Mr Thomas Banks coming to the Depondent to enquire about the bound of Mr Harvays Land & took a Certificate of the same out of the Office according to request of the sd Banks I went with him & showed him what I knew of the bound of Harvays Land & showed him the oute *Protupent* path & the place where the bound tree stood of Mr Harvays Land & the sd Banks after I had so shown him the sd Land of Harvays I heard howe that Thomas Banks took up some Land adjoining therunto.
