That about 4 or 5 years ago being at y^e house of Mr Jervis in Sassafras Riv^r there happened to be communication between Mr Jervis & Mr J^r Davd about y^e land y^e J^r Davd had bought of him y^e J^r Davd did then request y^e J^r Davd to pay for him y^e remainder of y^e tob y^e he was indebted to y^e J^r Davd for a piece of land y^e he y^e J^r Davd bought of him y^e J^r Davd upon which y^e J^r Davd offered y^e J^r Davd to go along with him y^e J^r Davd man his y^e J^r Davd would satisfy & pay him at his own plantation in Bohemia Riv^r. The said Mr Davd refused y^e J^r Davd payment & said y^e he would pay at his own plantation & y^e J^r Davd should bring it to y^e J^r Davd plantation & there he would receive it & not by bundle & if he then like it he would receive it & not otherwise. That about 4 or 5 years ago Mr Jervis requested this J^r to go with him to y^e house of Mr J^r Davd to tender him some bills which he had to offer him y^e J^r Davd would pay for land which y^e J^r Davd had bought of him y^e J^r Davd And when he came to y^e J^r Davd house y^e J^r Davd did then offer y^e J^r Davd for a bill for several pieces of land due to him in the Baltimore County to which Davd replied y^e he y^e J^r Davd would get it all together ready at one place he would take it if he liked it or else he might save himself y^e labour and moreover Mr Davd said y^e he y^e J^r Davd would discount y^e bill it would be good pay to him y^e J^r Davd Mr Davd's account he y^e J^r Davd did owe y^e J^r Davd Mr J^r Davd's account he y^e J^r Davd did owe y^e J^r Davd much more discount past at y^e time between them which J^r Davd doth not well remember & further saith not.
