 ye said doing of ye said Joseph & his Wife Ann^{es} as aforesaid
 & costs in this Court of Chancery are contrary to Equity &
 good Conscience & to ye great damage of ye said Robert
 Compt as aforesaid who hath in effect overpaid ye said last
 Bonds of ye ho ye said Robert ought not in equity to pay the
 Remainder in ye same manner as in ye Condition is specified
 but rather to be repaid (if there were Asses) the whole said
 three Bonds with Cost & damages. And whereas ye said
 Robert hath therefore prayed & obtained a Writ of Habeas
 & Injunct directed to ye said Joseph & Wife to oblige
 them to answer ye aforesaid bill of Complaint exhi-
 bited against them as aforesaid to May all further pro-
 ceedings at common Law till ye matter in equity
 should be determined Therefore this Hon^{ble} Court
 of Chancery upon hearing ye matter this ninth day
 of Octob^r 1695 doth order & decree of ye said Robert
 Mason Compt as aforesaid shall quietly enjoy &
 possess to him & his heirs forever the said Tract
 of land And ye shall likewise obtain all Cost &
 damages in this behalf wrongfully sustained.
