And it is likewise further ordered that the said James Neale shall also pay and allow unto the said John Balley his Cost and Damages by him Susteyned by Reason of j^r promised to be set up disrupted and Allowed of by his Excellency Charles Calvert Esq^r the Hon^{ble} Phillip Calvert Esq^r Chauncell. & the Hon^{ble} W^m Calvert Esq^r or any two of them. and what they or any two of them shall so set up compute and allow to be paid by the said James Neale to the said John Balley for his Cost and Damages as aforesaid. It is hereby further ordered that the same shall stand Ratified & Confirmed by the Decree of this Court to all intents and purposes without any appeal from the same or Repeals thereof, And the same is to be paid by the said James Neale to the said John Balley accordingly.

In Pursuance of an Ord^r made in this Cause the eleaventy day of February instant whereby it is Referred unto his Excellency Charles Esq^r Phillip Calvert. and William Calvert Esq^r or any two of them to set up compute and allow Cost & Damages for the said John Balley: (They did in the presence of the Compt^r Balley and his Attorney (none attending for the Def^t Neale) though due Notice was given to his Attorney) peruse and examine a Hoale of the particular Cost and Damages produced to them by the said John Balley. and seriously viewed the same. and duly considered thereof did think fitt & so order that the said John Balley be Allowed for his Cost and Charges expended in this cause the Sum of Twelve thousand Two hundred twenty eight pound of Tobacco and Charge for Chauncell^r Secretaries, Sheriffs Fees. and for his Imprisonment and other Fees. And further they did order to allow to the said John Balley for his Damages for staying here and being out of his Tobacco three yeares the sum of Twenty pound Sterling a Year. which in all Com^{es} to the sum of sixtie pound Sterling. which in Tobacco at one penny a pound Com^{es} to the sum of six hundred and thirtie pound of Tobacco. As also the sum of Eight pound Sterling for Eighty Hogheads of Tobacco being the produce of the said wynes to be paid by the said Neale to the said Balley, for the Imposition of two shillings a Hoghead lately layd upon Tobacco. the one moetye of the said Eight pound Sterling to be to the use of the said Balley and the other moetye to the use of the said Neithway. which said sum of Eight pound Sterling in Tobacco at one penny a pound Com^{es} also to the sum of Nynete hundred & twenty pound of Tobacco. All which said several sumes allowed for Cost & Damages as aforesaid doe in the whole in Tobacco Amount to the sume of Twenty Eight thousand five hundred forty & six pound of Tobacco.
