I WITNESS heretofore that i^r to day 26th day of May 1694 Jn^r. Farmer
 of Calvert County planter Exhibited his Bill of Complaint in writing Hono. Sir.
 ag^t Jn^r. Sollars Gentle & Nich^s. Fountaine planter dfts thereto witnesseth
 fortht that Francis Lord Prop^r by his patent under his great Seal dat^t
 the 20th day of Octob^r 1688 did grant to one W^m. Lowry of same
 planter a piece of Land called Lowrys Strand lying in fishing Creek
 next the Land of Francis Swinburne on the west in the Land of
 Arthur Thompson on the North begining at y^e sd Thompsons
 white Oak bound tree wth a line by the sd Thompsons land South
 west for the length of 160 pches to a bounded white Oak in the North
 line of the Land of Richard Smith wth y^e P. Smiths line North for
 the length of 320 pches to a bounded white Oak on the North line
 wth a line drawn North west for^r length of 150 pches to a mark
 white Oak in the South line of the sd Swinburne land on y^e East line
 wth the said line South for the length of 320 pches to y^e first bound
 tree containing y^e land out for 300 acres more or less this the sd W^m. Lowry
 being therby become Seized of the sd Land did the 20th of March 1682 for
 the Consideration of 9000. of tobacco paid by y^e Compt^t Bargained & sold the
 said Land to the Compt^t & his heirs & assigns for ever wth a general warra
 & other small Covenants in the Deed made there of as by the said
 may more at large appear at the said Deed the sd W^m. Lowry
 gave to the Compt^t a Bond of 18000. tobacco penalty for non payment of
 the Covenants in the said Deed that he pl^t therby to com^t Bond
 of the sum of y^e sd Dft. Sollars having a desire to purchase y^e said
 of the Compt^t because it lay contigous to other Land of y^e sd Sollars
 Compt^t agreed to sell the same to him accordingly having therew^r
 y^e Sollars by like by the said Deed from Lowry according to y^e payment
 the sd Sollars ordered this like Survey and to be drawn for y^e Compt^t
 to sale to Sollars as Lowry had done to y^e Compt^t wth the Covenants
 & gen^r warrant as above in Compt^t for y^e Consideration of 11000. of
 tobacco to him paid by Sollars did seal & execute accordingly and the
 Sollars did then request of y^e Compt^t a bond of 22000. of tobacco to
 & form y^e Covenants in the same Deed to wth y^e Compt^t appointed and
 sealed knowing that no northe y^e Lowry had not done any act
 to
